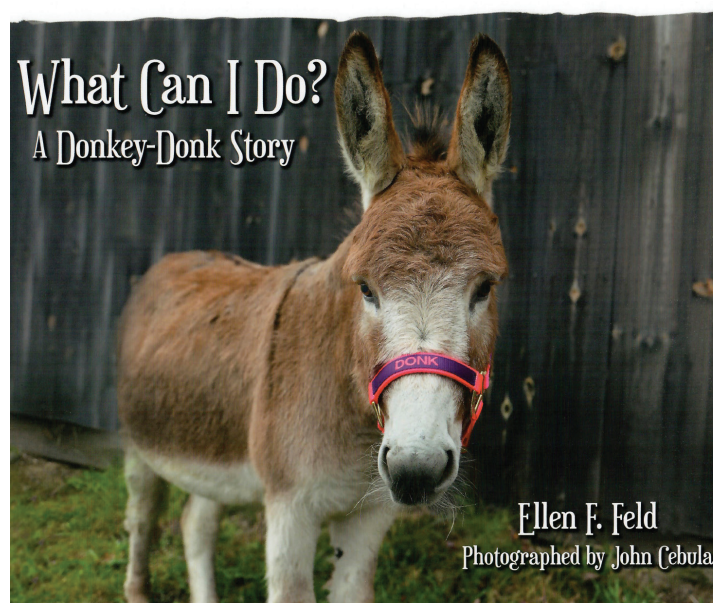

We are introduced to her adorable miniature donkey "Donkey-Donk", and some of the other horses at her barn, Willow Bend Morgan's. Thanks to the creative photography of John Cebula, we enjoyed a clear picture of her outstanding donkey and all of his adventures. Her children's books are unique, whimsical, and written for early readers. The softcover glossy pages make a perfect stocking stuffer for children everywhere.

Feld also offers an Equine component for children who love law enforcement. She introduces us to Liam, a police horse in Lancaster, PA. Cebula again contributes wonderfully depicted photography paired
